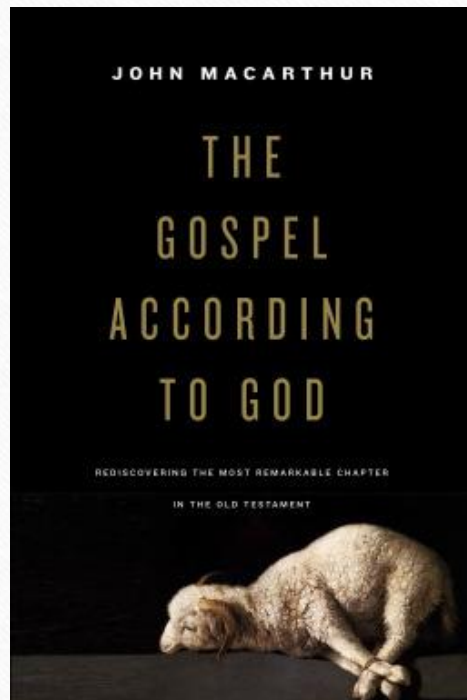

“Those verses are a summary statement that introduces two contrasting ideas – themes that will loom large in chapter 53. Specifically, the three verses at the end of chapter 52 reveal that Israel’s Messiah and King, the Lord Jesus Christ will both suffer and be exalted.”

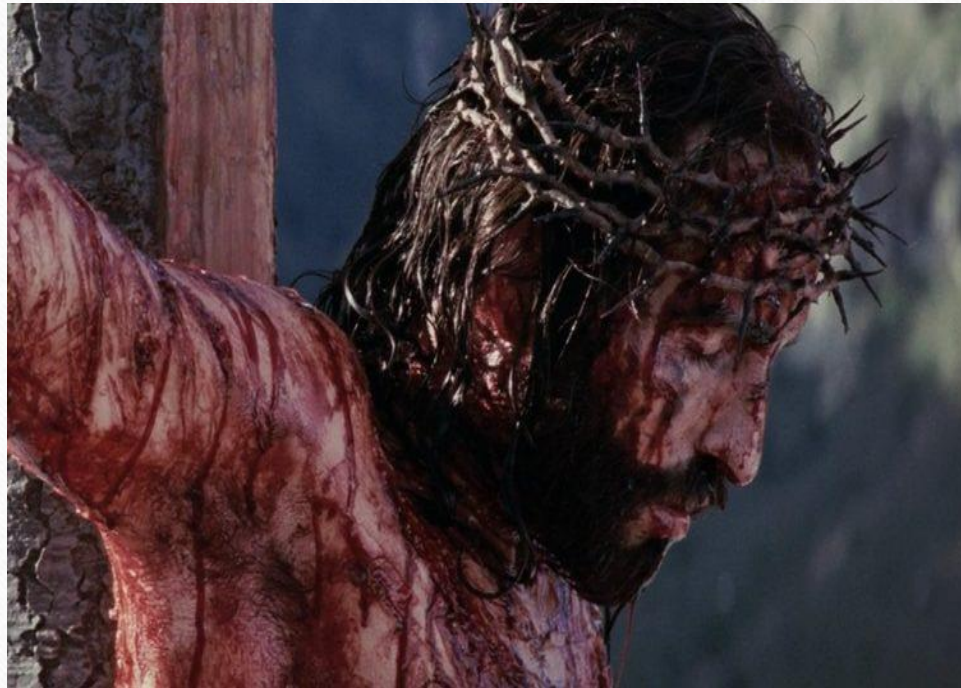

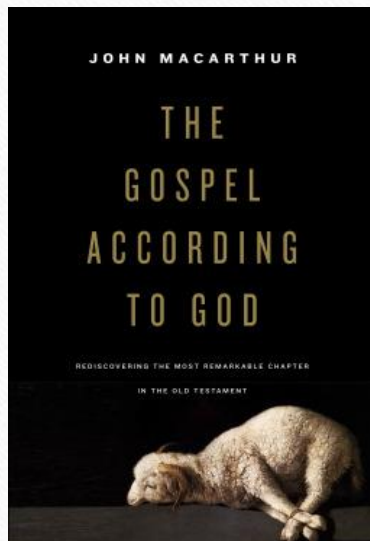

**“He had no form or majesty that we should look at him, and no beauty that we should desire him” (Isaiah 53:2b).**

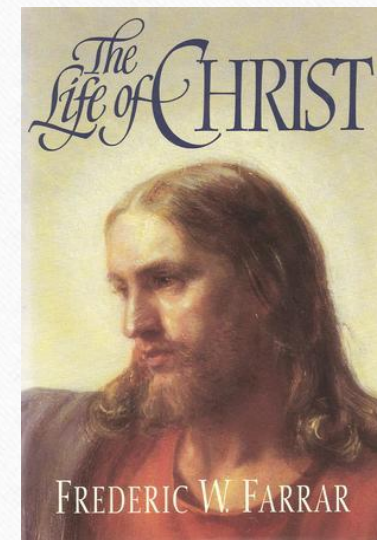
